The artwork was rediscovered in the estate of Erich Kästner, for whom Trier had provided illustrations for Emil and the Detectives, and depicts a lighthearted vacation cruise aboard a colorful yacht. Passengers and sea creatures alike frolic on this fanciful ocean except for a certain pet Pekingese. The little dog seems entirely unimpressed by the goings-on, yet by the end even he is eager to return for another voyage next year. 32.
