These will produce significant project management challenges as well as unin-tended consequences among the initiatives that now include the Flats Sequencing System, Intelligent Mail barcode, plant network and post office optimization, 6-to 5-day mail delivery, and a major transformation of its sales and marketing effort. A second concern is that a large portion of the Postal Service fi-nancial loss is not a result of the Postal Service...
