Pursuant to a congressional request, GAO examined the issue of nondeployable military personnel for Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm, focusing on: (1) the extent of nondeployable personnel; (2) the factors contributing to nondeployability; and (3) systemic weaknesses that could impair future readiness and deployability. GAO found that: (1) it could not determine the extent of nondeployable personnel because of insufficient data; (2) available data indicated such causes of nondeployability as incomplete training, varying medical conditions, and personal problems; (3) the Department of Defense (DOD) stated that nondeployable personnel were not a serious problem because the services were able to replace them with other personnel; and (4) available data suggest that systemic weaknesses exacerbated nondeployability problems in the peacetime screening of active and reserve personnel.
